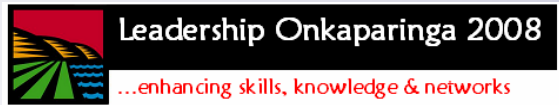

- lead and facilitate change



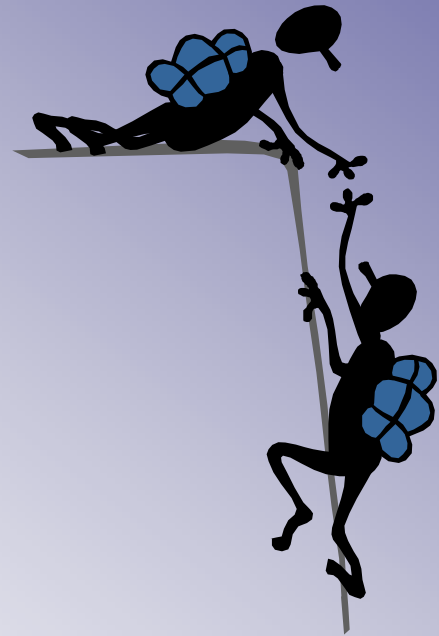
Afternoon skill development sessions include

Leadership Onkaparinga Outcomes

- over 90% attendance
- 85% finished the course
- 90% gained two nationally accredited Cert IV competency units
- 40% were offered part-time and/or casual employment - far exceeded estimate
- 23% have enrolled in further study
- 100% volunteering in their communities
